STORY

The Coffee: This Grade 3 Organic Ethiopian Limmu comes from the Burka Gudina Estate. Ibrahim Hussein is a third generation farmer and owner of the Burka Gudina Estate. Ibrahim purchased the estate over 10 years ago and named the land Burka Gudina, translating to "Where the blessings grow."

The estate uses 150 hectares of farmland for coffee production and employs 120 people during the peak season. Over half the trees covering the farm are acacia trees, and the rest are a mix of other endemic forest trees including wanza (Sudan teak), grevillea, and berbera (African teak). In the shade of this beautiful forest, Ibrahim grows carefully selected local varieties of coffee that grow well in high altitudes and that are resistant to disease. The coffee is grown without added pesticides, chemicals or synthetic fertilizers with shade provided by the native trees, contributing to the biodiversity of the region.

Growing altitude at Burka Gudina ranges from 1,850-2,100 masl.
