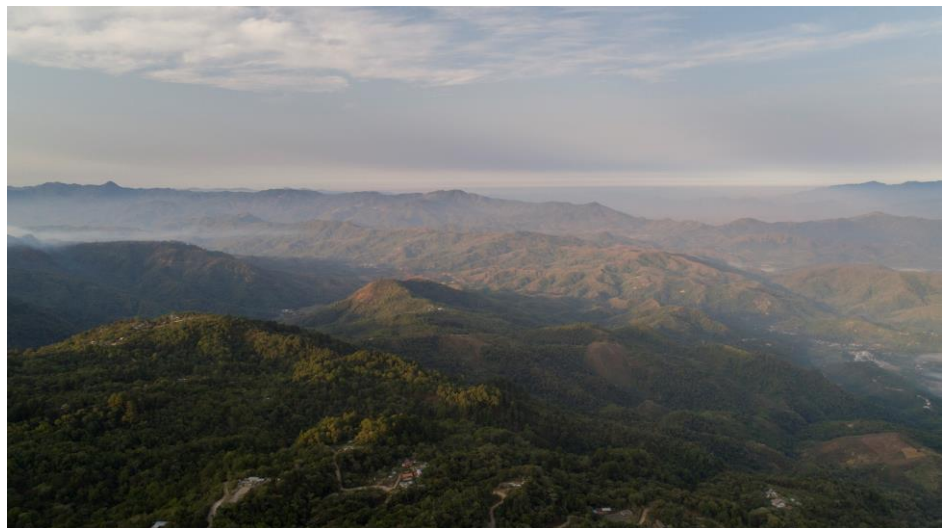
STORY

Cafe Capitan is about 2 years old. At the point of inception, they broke off from a larger umbrella cooperative to work on pursuing higher quality and delivering higher premiums to farmers. They work with farmers in the pueblos of Comunidad Monterey, Santerita, Laguna del Cofre, Capitan, and Las Pilas.

THE REGION

The chief producing states are Chiapas, Veracruz, Puebla and Oaxaca and the main varieties are Typica, Caturra, Bourbon, Catuai, Mundo Novo, Garnica, Catimor, Maragogype and Robusta.

Chiapas, which reaches up to the Guatemalan border, is by far the largest production region and accounts for one third of the total crop.
